Methodological change for figures 37 and 38: since I January 2009, a new statistical collection and reporting methodology has been used for TARGET2 data in order to improve the quality of these data. This must be taken into account when comparing earlier data. Furthermore, as of 2009, no distinction is made between domestic and cross-border payments.

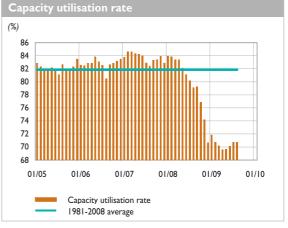
Table 2 Industrial activity indicators – Monthly Business Survey – France (seasonally-adjusted data)

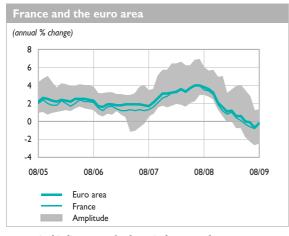

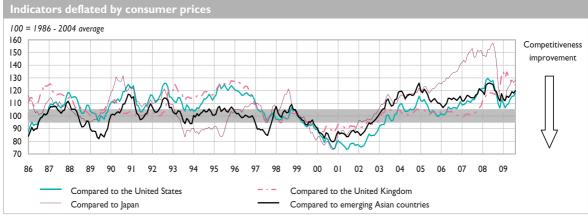

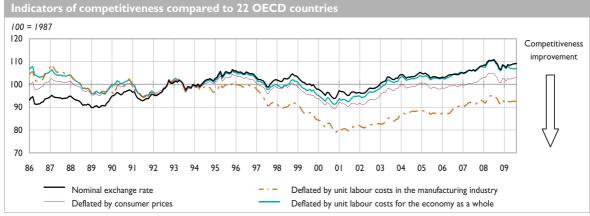

The competitiveness of France's economy







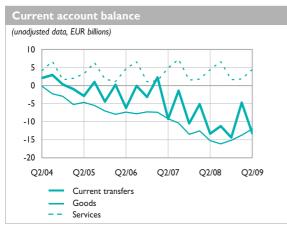

Debt securities and quoted shares issued by French residents, by sector





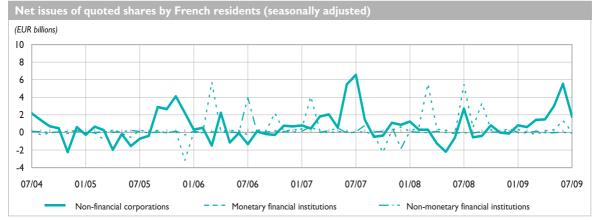
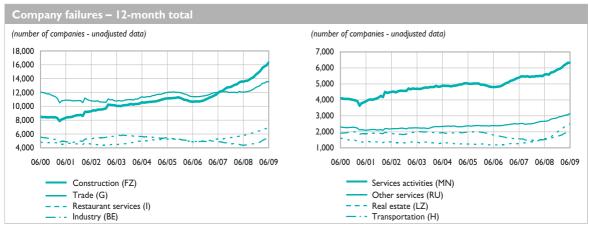
