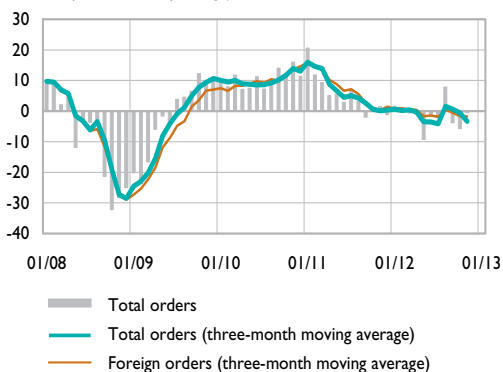
Business sentiment indicator

(100 = 1981 – last value)



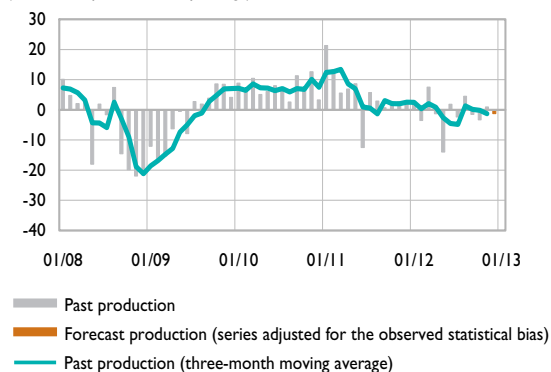

(balance of opinions; monthly change)



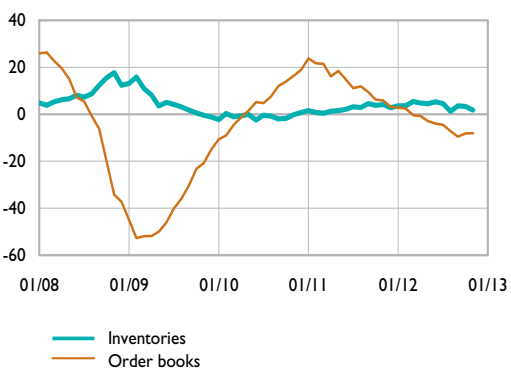

(balance of opinions; monthly change)



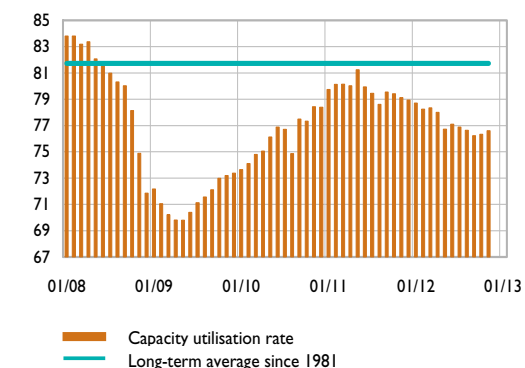
Inventories and order books ^{a)}

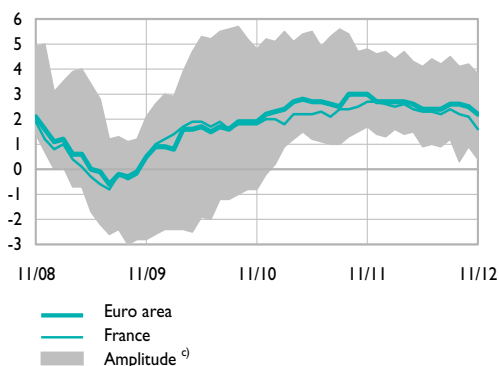

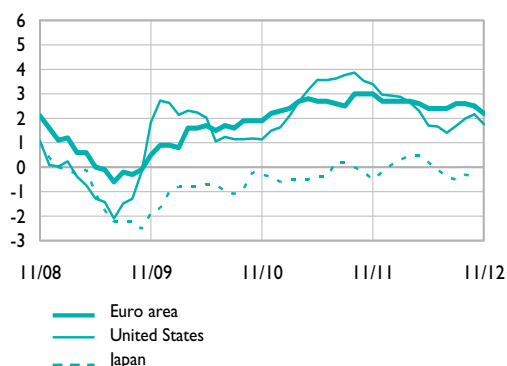
France and the euro area

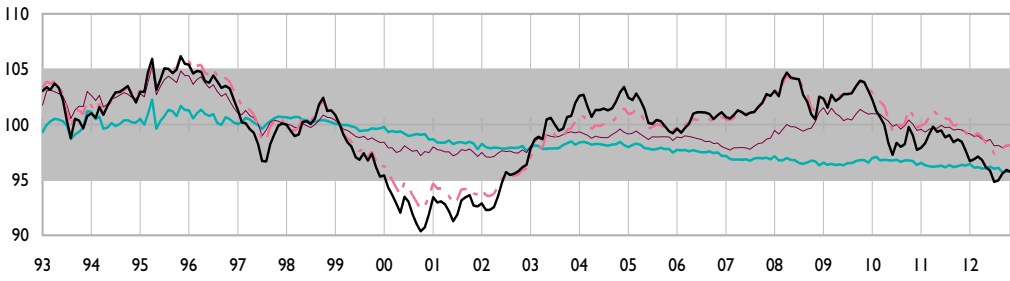

(1st quarter 1999 = 100)



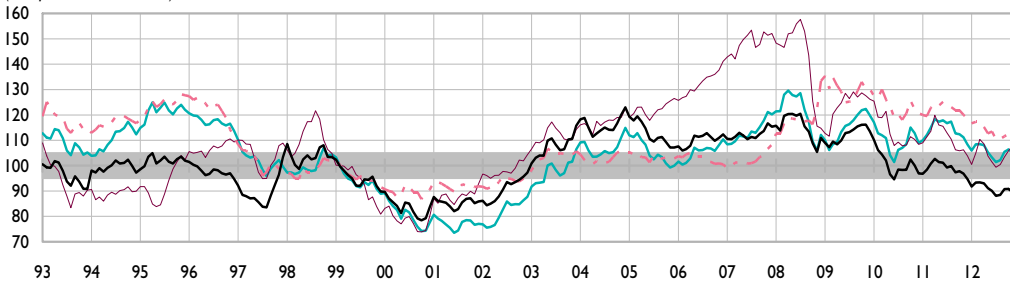

(1st quarter 1999 = 100)



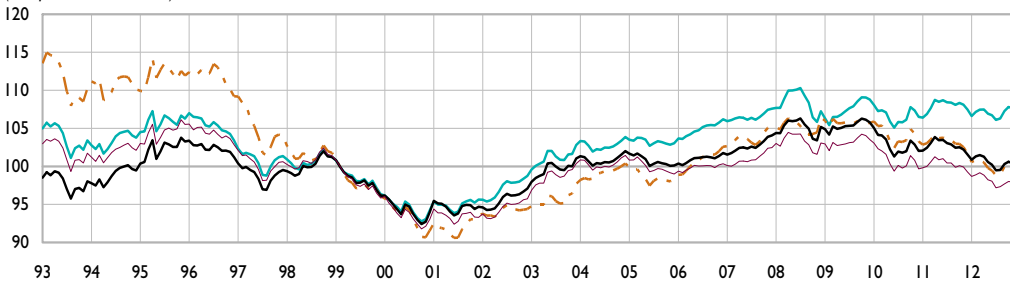

Competitiveness improvement



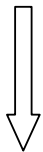
Indicators of competitiveness compared to 24 OECD countries

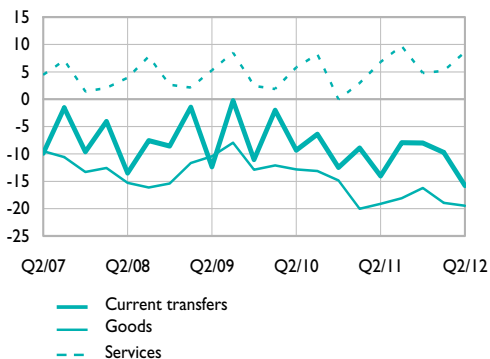

(unadjusted data, EUR billions)

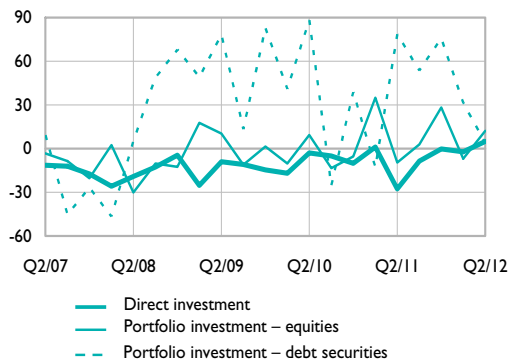

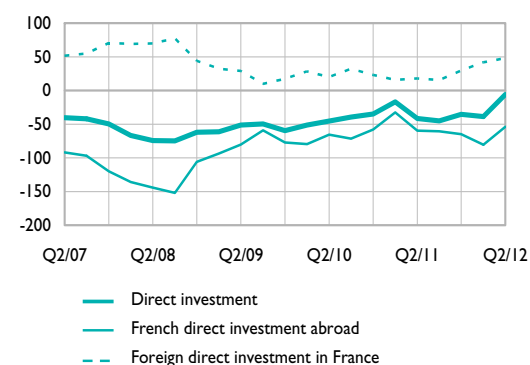

(cumulated flows over 4 quarters)

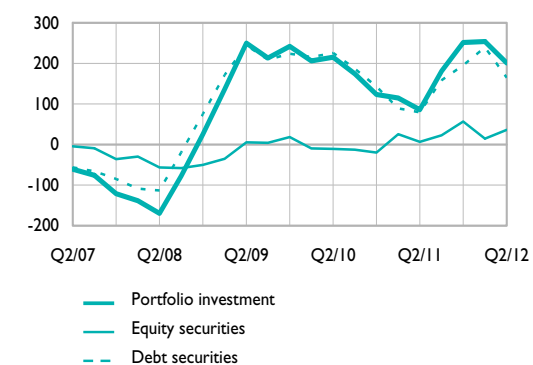

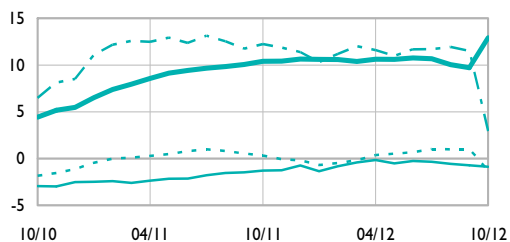

(annual percentage growth rate)

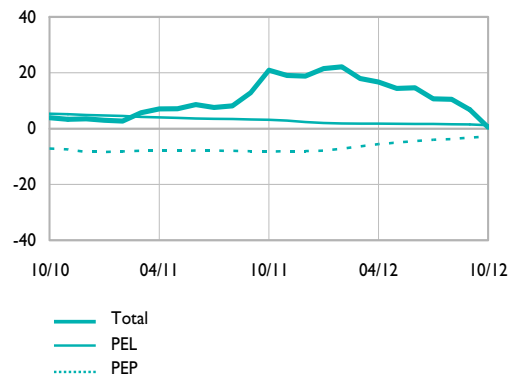
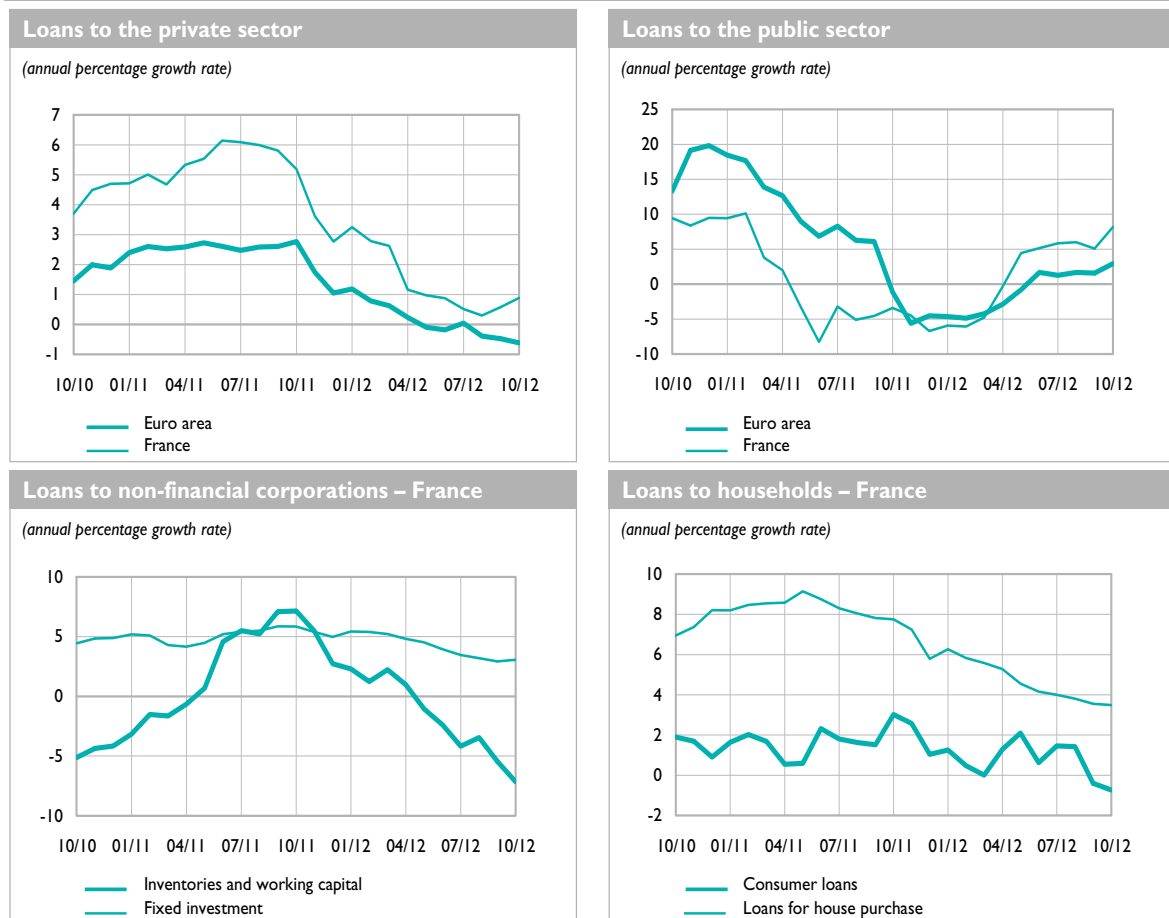

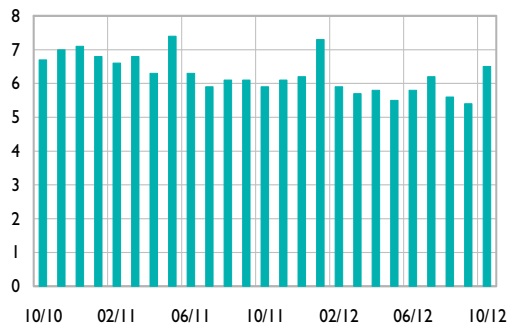

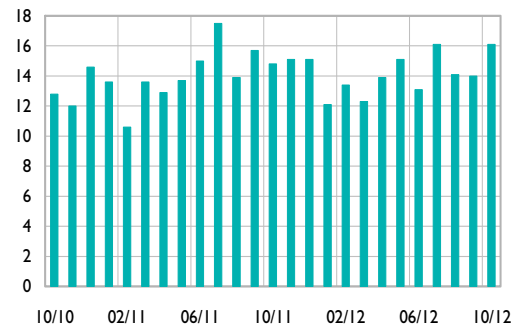
Non-financial corporations – Loans ≤ 1 million euro

(monthly flows - seasonally adjusted - in euro billions)



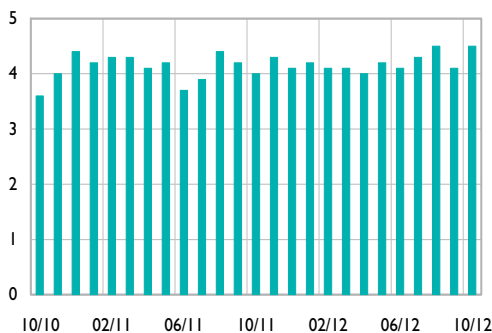
Non-financial corporations – Loans > 1 million euro

(monthly flows - seasonally adjusted - in euro billions)



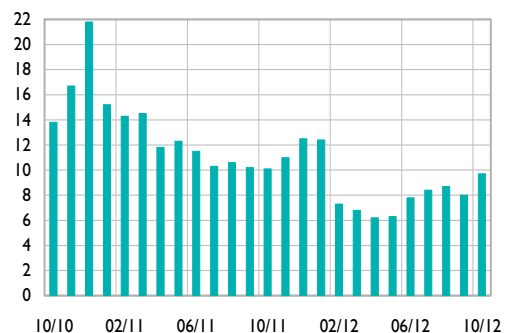
Households - Cash loans

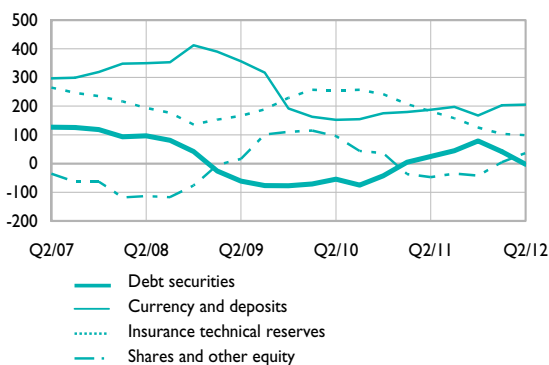

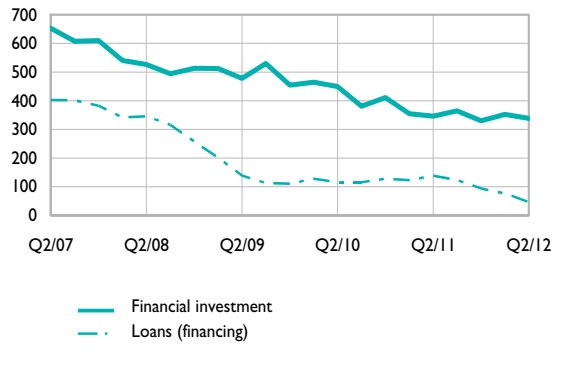
Investment flows

(EUR billions, cumulated flows over 4 quarters)

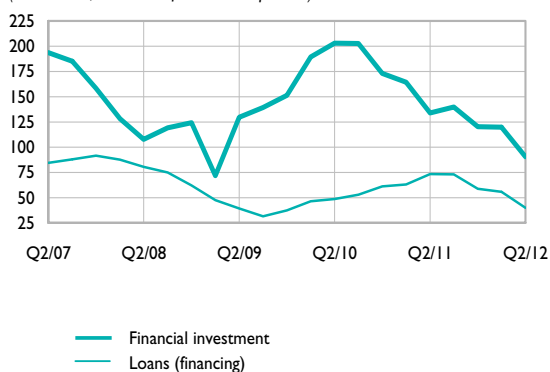


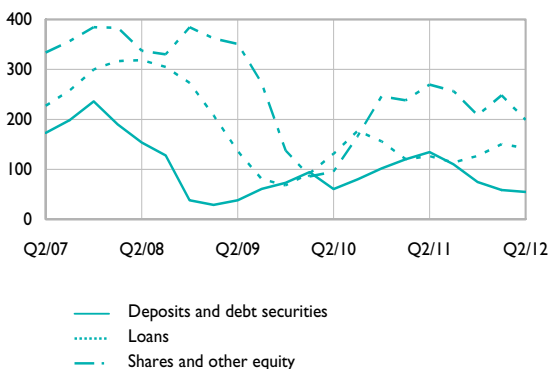

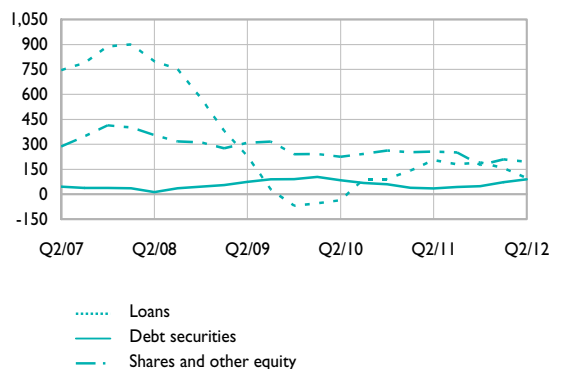
Investment flows

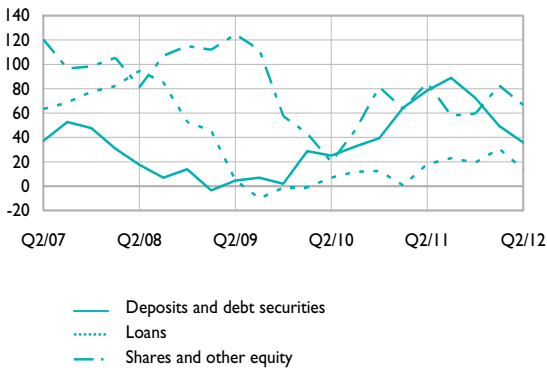

(EUR billions, cumulated flows over 4 quarters)

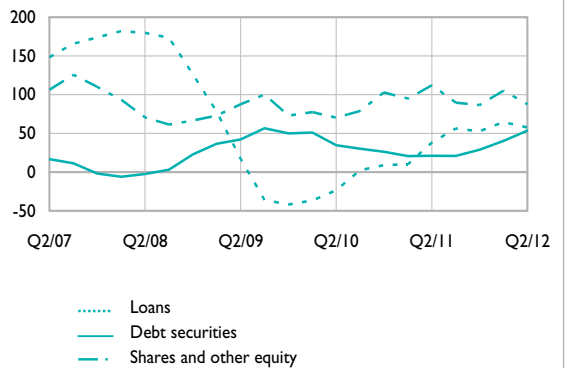


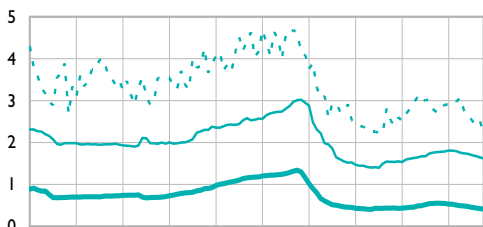

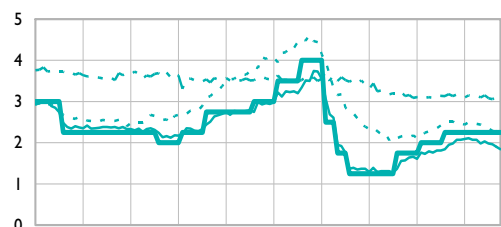

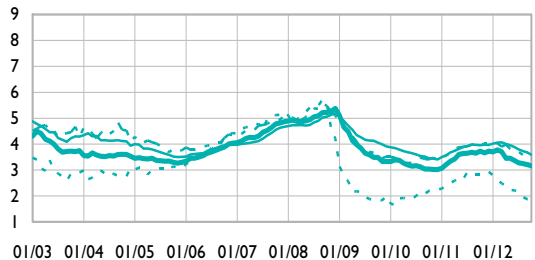

(EUR billions, daily average for the reserve maintenance period from 12 September to 9 October 2012)

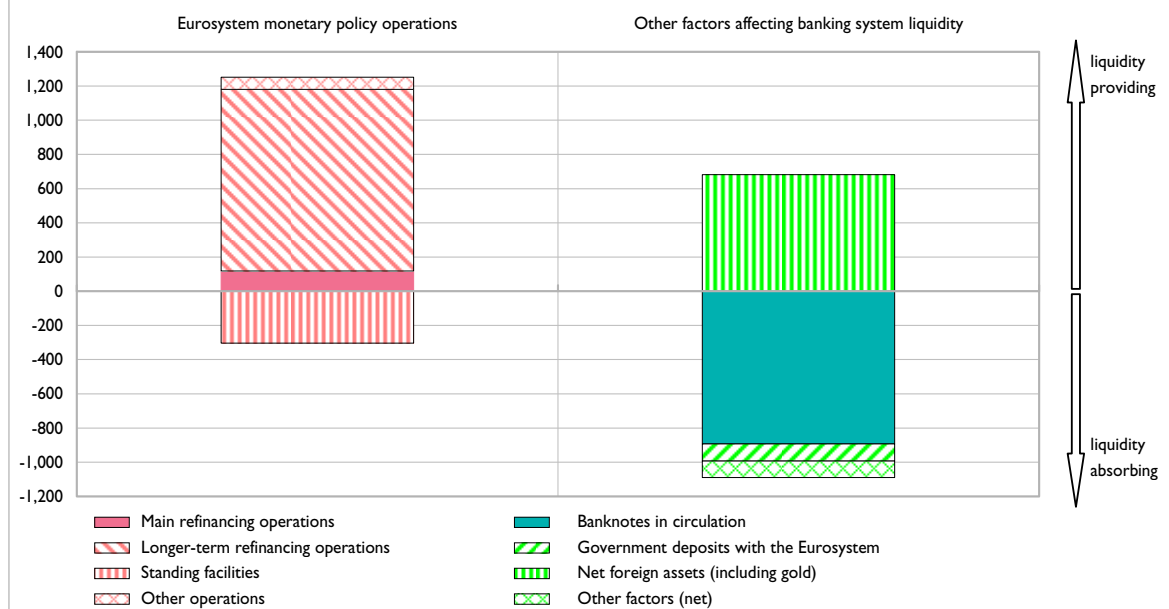

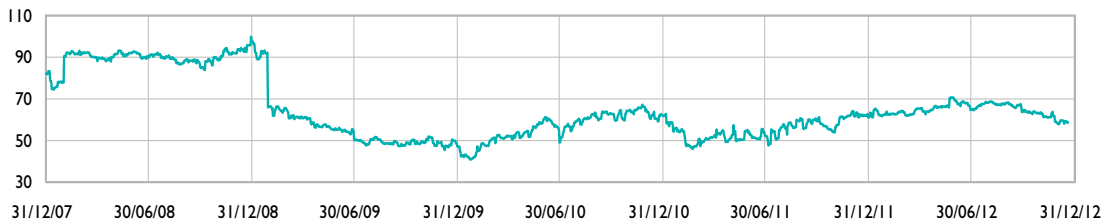
Certificates of deposit

(daily outstanding amounts in EUR billions)



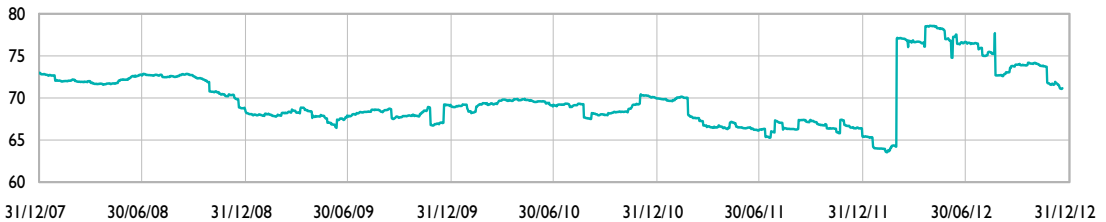
Commercial paper

(daily outstanding amounts in EUR billions)

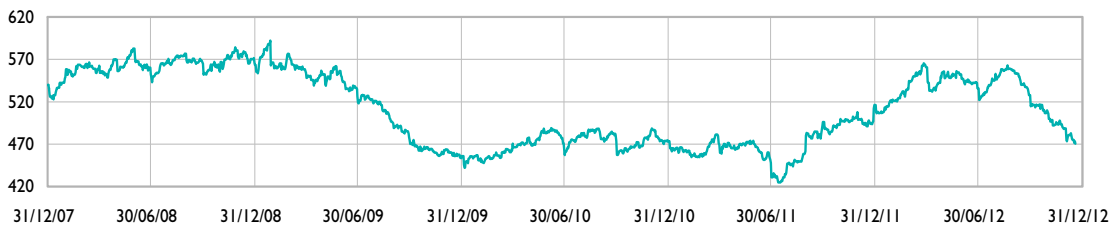

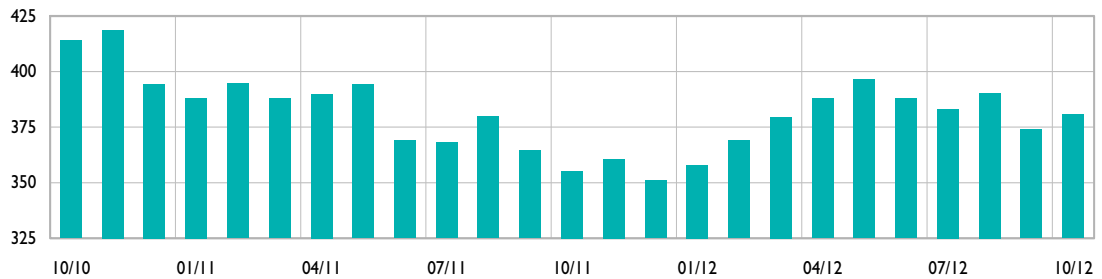

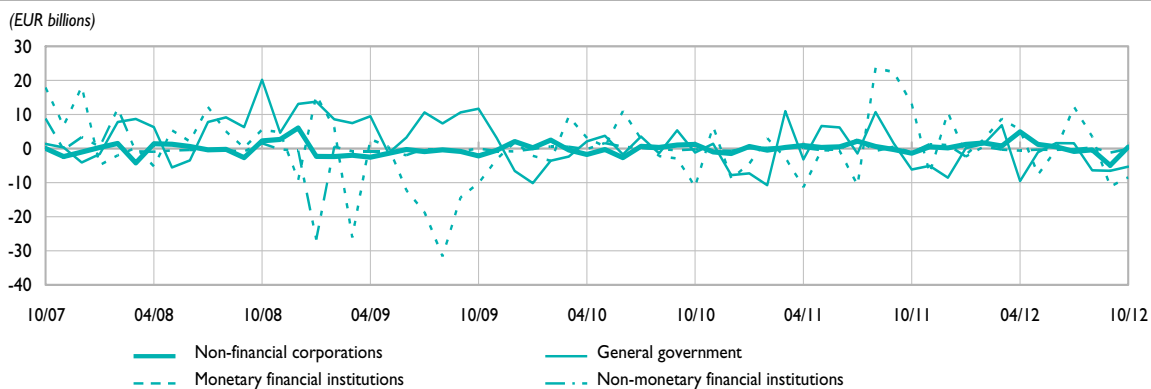

Net issues of quoted shares by French residents (seasonally adjusted)

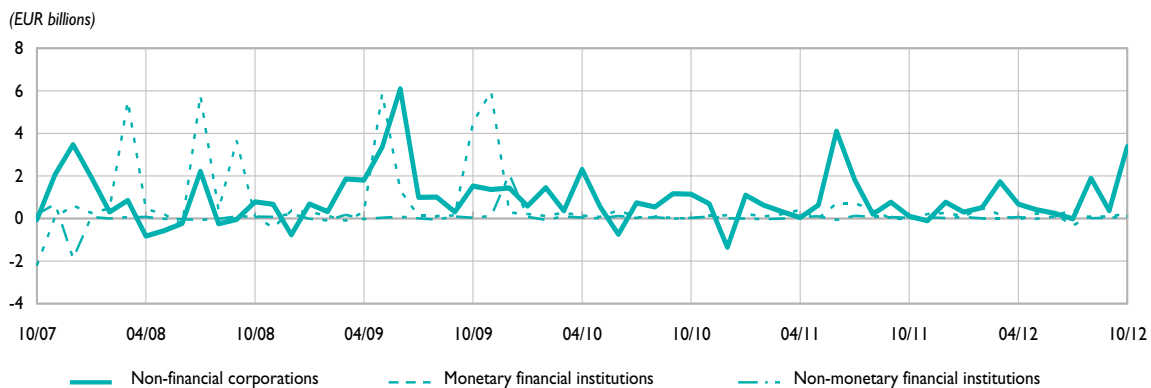


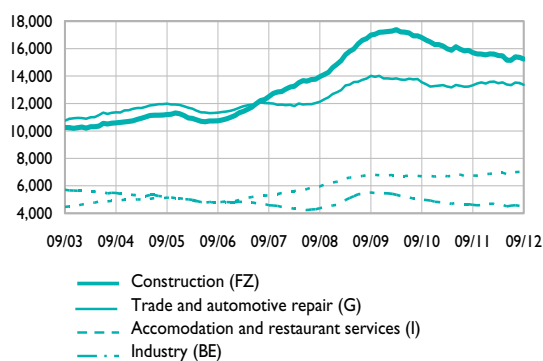

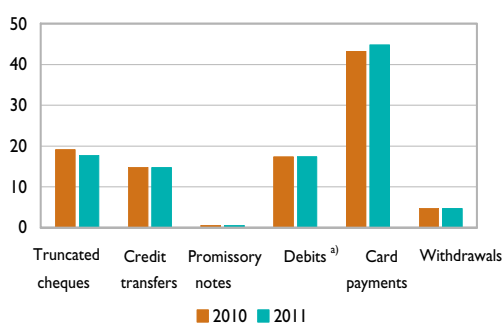
Market share developments

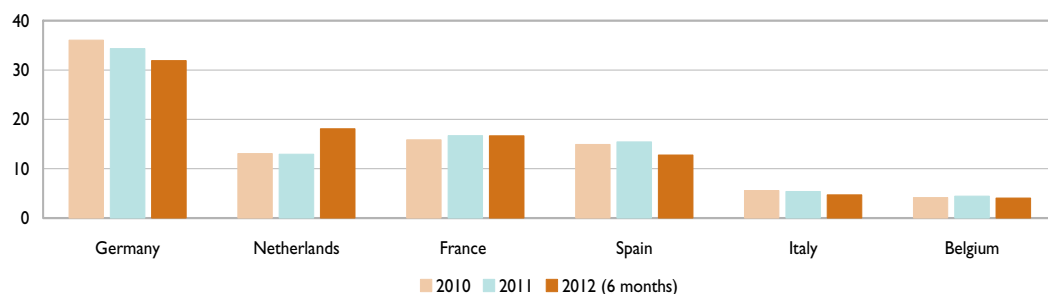

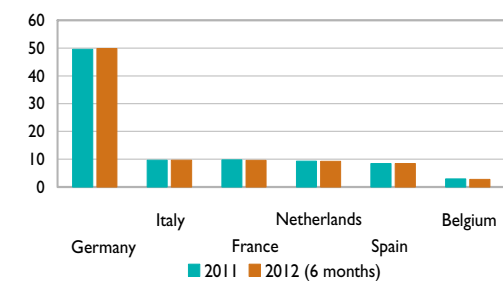

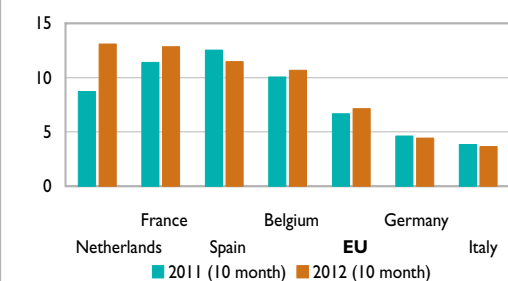
Market share of each financial centre in the TARGET2 system

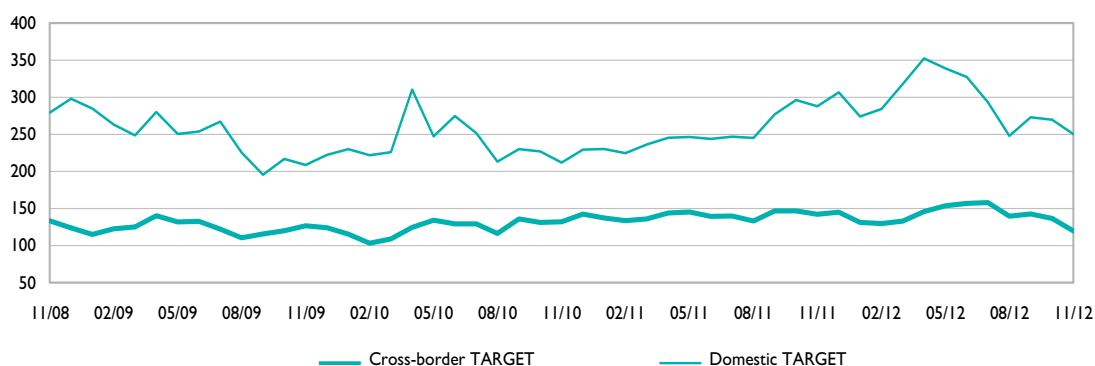

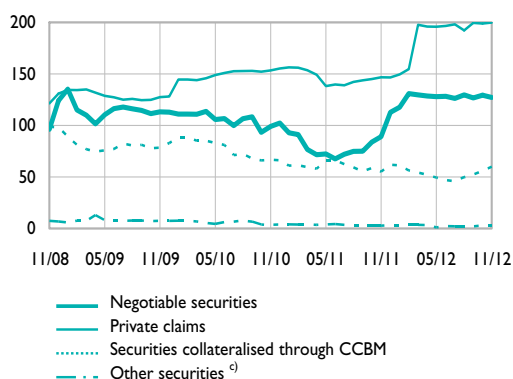
Monthly change in amounts exchanged in French payment systems^{a)}

(EUR billions, daily average)

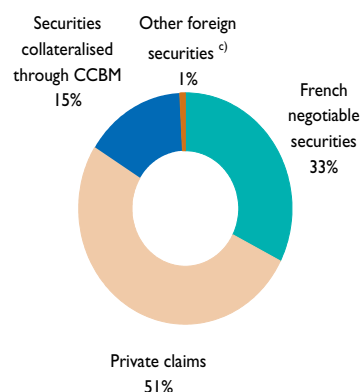


Monthly change in collateral^{b)}
